

Special Usage of the 100 yd. Range

Special and qualifying conditions listed below will apply to all rifle shooters. The outdoor range will be closed to casual shooters (general membership) during these activities.

1. A Range Safety Officer (RSO) will be present and in charge of the range during these times. Practice activity will not take place if a range officer is not present. No other persons are allowed to operate the outdoor range, during the Practice scheduled times and days.
2. The Range Safety Officer will be totally in charge of the range and all club members must comply with the Range Officer's rules or directions or they will not be allowed on the firing line and could be removed from the range.
3. Only Military Rifles, U.S. Service Rifles and/or Match Rifles will be allowed on the 100 yd. firing points. Hunting rifles, deer rifles and other sporting firearms will not be allowed on these firing points.
4. The Range Safety Officer (RSO) will hang a sign indicating CLOSED RANGE at the range sign-in book during these activities. *This sign will indicate the closure of the range – i.e. "HP Rifle Practice, Closed Range."*
5. All rifles when loaded will not be raised above the target line. There will be no exceptions to this rule.
